

## ADVERTISEMENT TO BIDDERS

The ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DETROIT is soliciting competitive unit price general contract bids for the following project:

### GEORGIA STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The work for this project is described in a Bid Package available via the DEGC website at [www.degc.org](http://www.degc.org) and [www.bidnetdirect.com/mitn](http://www.bidnetdirect.com/mitn), beginning on Tuesday, March 13, 2018. The project site is on Georgia Street, generally bound by Mt. Elliot St to the West and St. Cyril to the East, in the City of Detroit. Furthermore, the scope of work for this project shall generally include:

1. Removal of all existing street pavement, curbs, sidewalks, signage, and selected utilities within the project area.
2. Installation of a new storm water sewer system within the rights-of-way.
3. Coordination with DTE Energy, Public Lighting Authority for the removal and replacement of (parts of) lighting system within the rights-of-way.
4. Coordination with Conrail and other Rail contractors for their reconstruction of the two rail crossings on Georgia.
5. Installation of new hydrants, traffic signal, limited driveways, concrete street pavement and sidewalks, install of limited HMA at road transition areas.
6. Installation of pavement markings and signage within the general project area.
7. Restoration of the disturbed areas with topsoil, seed, and mulch.

All Bidders shall comply with the prevailing Equal Opportunity and Labor Standard Provisions of the City of Detroit, as described in the Bid Package. Each Bidder must demonstrate its ability to obtain Human Rights Clearance from the City of Detroit as a condition of award ability.
