The eligible property in the Plan includes seven parcels. The Property is located on the north side of Frederick Street in the Art Center neighborhood of Detroit’s Midtown and is bounded by Beaubien Street to the west, Frederick Street to the south, St. Antoine Street to the east, and the alleyway to the north.
